



Route 1015 Little Deer Creek Valley Road Slide Remediation Work begins Monday in Indiana Township

Pittsburgh, PA – PennDOT District 11 is announcing slide remediation work on Little Deer Creek Valley Road (Route 1015) in Indiana Township, Allegheny County, will begin Monday, March 6 weather permitting.

Slide remediation work will occur on Little Deer Creek Valley Road between Krnyevich Lane and Lefever Hill Road/Log Cabin Road. To allow the work to begin, an around-the-clock closure will occur from 6 a.m. Monday morning continuously through Saturday, May 6. Traffic will be detoured.

POSTED DETOUR

Southbound Traffic

- Little Deer Creek Valley Road to Starr Road (Route 1026)
- Turn left onto East Union Road (Route 1025)
- East Union Road becomes Rich Hill Road
- Bear left onto Lefever Hill Road
- Follow Lefever Hill Road to Little Deer Creek Valley Road
- End detour

Northbound Traffic

- Same detour in the opposite direction

Allison Park Contractors will conduct the remediation work. Approximately 3,200 vehicles use the roadway on an average day.

Motorists are advised to use caution and allow extra time when traveling through the area.
