



## You've just lost or found a pet... what do you do next?

- Notify your local police department (Indiana Township: 412-767-5333, option 1)
- Check on-line sites for postings: [www.petharbor.com](http://www.petharbor.com) and CraigsList's pet section and their lost and found section
- Check Animal Friends' online lost and found section for tips and helpful documents.
- Notify the other two local shelters, the Western Pennsylvania Humane Society at 412-321-4625 and the Animal Rescue League at 412-661-6452.
- Be sure to let your neighbors and local vet offices know you are missing your pet. It is also helpful to post fliers with a photo throughout your area.
- The 24-48 hours are the most critical! Contact the animal control facility that services your neighborhood. (Hoffman Kennel, 724-468-5505)
- If your lost or found pet was originally from Animal Friends, please call 412-847-7000 and ask the operator to page the adoption team.

**HOW TO REPORT ANIMAL CRUELTY:** Call Animal Friends Animal Police: 412-847-7066 any time of the day or night to give your report. Make sure you have a correct address when reporting a situation. If you do not know the address, name a nearby cross street or a nearby address.

Please leave an address, a brief synopsis of the concern and a call-back number. Please do not leave a message asking for a call back to give the information...leave all the information on the answering service message so that Animal Friends Police Officers can act IMMEDIATELY.
