## **PUBLIC HEARING**

**Transfer of Liquor License to Il Pizzaiolo, III, LLC**

**September 8, 2015**

A public hearing was held to take public comment on the transfer of a Liquor License from Penn Hills, PA to Il Pizzaiolo, III, LLC to be located in "The Stables of Hartwood", 3405 Harts Run Road, Glenshaw, PA 15116, in an O/C Office Flex Commercial Zoning District. The meeting was called to order at 6:45 p.m. by Mayor Daniel L. Taylor, and was recorded on audio cassette. It was duly advertised on August 21, 2015, and August 28, 2015, in the "Valley News Dispatch".

Supervisors in attendance were Darrin Krally, Michael Schurko, and Daniel L. Taylor. Also in attendance were Manager Daniel Anderson, Chief of Police Robert W. Wilson, Code Enforcement Officer Jeffrey Curti, Recording Secretary Carolyn Kustra, and Solicitor David Mongillo for Irving S. Firman.

Holly Guna of Caputo, Caputo, and Regan, P.C. explained the proposed authentic Italian Restaurant will have outdoor seating for approximately 48 customers, and approximately 80 indoor seats, with 8-10 seats at the bar. A banquet room will also be available. The Restaurant will operate Monday -Thursday, 11:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m., Friday and Saturday 11:00 a.m. - 11:00 p.m., and Sunday Noon - 9:00 p.m.
