ORDINANCE NO. 367

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF INDIANA, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING AND RESTATING SECTION 460.01 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF INDIANA TO DESIGNATE AREAS WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP OF INDIANA IN WHICH PARKING IS PROHIBITED AND AMENDING AND RESTATING SECTION 460.99 TO ESTABLISH PENALTIES FOR PARKING VIOLATIONS

WHEREAS, the Township of Indiana (the "Township") has adopted ordinances prohibiting parking on certain streets within the Township, as set forth in the Codified Ordinances of the Township of Indiana, Chapter 460, Section 460.01; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Indiana has recently accepted various new public roads and desires to prohibit parking on those and other streets throughout the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Township has the authority under 75 Pa C.S. § 6301 to implement an ordinance which requires that penalties for the violation of Township parking regulations be paid to the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Indiana finds that certain amendments to its parking regulations are necessary as to promote the convenient and safe movement of motor vehicles within and through the Township and to adequately protect both the safety and welfare of the citizens and residents of the Township as well as the traveling public.

NOW THEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Indiana hereby ordains as follows:

Section 1. Parking Prohibited in the Following Streets

Section 460.01 of Chapter 460 of the Codified Ordinances of the Township of Indiana shall be deleted in its entirety and amended to read as follows:

460.01 PROHIBITED AREAS

(a) No person shall park any vehicle on any of the following roadways or portions thereof during the periods stated herein:

All parking prohibitions established subsequent to this Ordinance shall be inserted within the list above in their proper alphabetical order.

(b) Parking shall be prohibited within or along the perimeter of all cul-de-sacs in Indiana Township at all times. Parking shall also be prohibited within fifty (50) feet of the end of all dead-end streets within the Township at all times.

(c) Any vehicle parked along any street within Indiana Township shall be parked no further than twelve (12) inches from the curb.

(d) The Chief of Police or his designee may allow temporary parking of vehicles upon any of the above streets, provided that a resident of said street makes such a request to the Police

Department in advance, in the event of a social gathering, function or neighborhood event. The allowance of temporary parking shall be for a period of no more than six (6) hours and may not be requested by a Township resident more than six (6) times in a calendar year. A granted temporary parking allowance may be revoked by the Police Department in the event that the Chief of Police or his designee determines that the health or safety of the residents of the Township would be negatively affected by the allowance.

(e) The loading or unloading of commercial vans, trucks or other vehicles for deliveries or moving shall not be prohibited nor shall the parking of such vehicles be prohibited on residential streets when the same are so parked so as to provide services, improvements or repairs as needed by the residents of the street where parked. In the event that the loading, unloading or parking of said vehicles creates an unsafe driving condition or unreasonably hinders the efficient movement of vehicles, said vehicle(s) shall be deemed to be in violation of Section (a) above.

Section 2. Penalty for Parking Violations

Section 460.99 of the Codified Ordinances of the Township of Indiana shall be deleted in its entirety, renamed and amended to read as follows:

460.99 PENALTY AND TICKETING FOR VIOLATION OF THIS CHAPTER

(a) It shall be the duty of the police officers of the Township, acting in accordance with the direction of the Chief of Police, to report each violation of this Chapter, including:

- (1) The date, hour and location of the violation;
- (2) The license plate number of the vehicle; and
- (3) Any other facts, the knowledge of which is necessary for a thorough understanding of the circumstances and is necessary for issuance of a state citation.

(b) If an individual is in violation of a parking provision within this Chapter, an Indiana Township police officer shall place on or attach to the vehicle a notice to the owner or driver of the vehicle that the vehicle was parked in violation of this Chapter and instructing the owner or driver that if he will report to the Indiana Township Police Station and tender payment of Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) within fifteen (15) days of issuance of the notice, or if he mails a check or money order to the Police Department within the time limit, that act will save the violator from prosecution and issuance of a citation.

(c) Any person who violates any provision of this Chapter and who fails to pay the fine in the manner set forth in section (b) above shall be issued a citation within thirty (30) days of the initial violation and, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine in accordance with the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code, 75 Pa C.S. §§ 101 et seq.

Section 3. Effectuation.

The Township Manager or his designee is hereby authorized and directed to place appropriate signage to effectuate the provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 4. Effective Date


This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon enactment and shall repeal all other incompatible ordinances.

Section 5. Severability

If a final decision of a court of competent jurisdiction holds any provision of this Ordinance or the application of any provision of this Ordinance to any circumstance to be illegal or unconstitutional, the other provisions of this Ordinance and the application of such provisions to other circumstances shall remain in full force and effect.
